



HERE'S THE ANSWER ---to the most frequently asked questions

We strive to ensure that our members have the right information they need to make decisions concerning our Chapter. Q. When are the chapter meetings?

A. Our chapter meets on the first Wednesday of every month at Lone Wolf Harley-Davidson. We usually enjoy a meal at 6:00pm with a meeting following at 7:00pm. Dinner is normally no more than \$10 per person. Check the club webpage calendar, our Facebook page and your email for more information on what's happening at each Chapter meeting.

Q. What are the annual dues and how are they used?

A. Dues are \$20 per year. The Chapter, like any organization, has operating costs such as printing the newsletter, monthly meetings, prizes, postage, maintaining the website, and many other expenses that keep the Chapter operating.

Q. Does paying my National dues also cover the Local Chapter dues?

A. National Membership & Local Membership are two separate memberships.

Q. Can I pay my National dues at the Dealership or a Chapter meeting?

A. National dues are paid by either calling Harley Davidson HOG or going to the National website <https://members.hog.com>. Only Local dues can be paid at the Dealership or Chapter meeting.

Q. Can anyone join the Lone Wolf HOG chapter?

A. As long as you have a current National Membership, then you can join the local chapter.

Q. How do I find out more about upcoming events, rides, etc.?

A. Visit the Chapter website at www.lonewolfhog.com and review the event calendar or our Facebook page at www.facebook.com/lonewolfhog has current event updates. The Chapter also sends out e-mail to its paid members several times a month. Please make sure our membership officer has your current e-mail address.

Q. What types of volunteer opportunities could I help with?

A. There are always opportunities such as hot dog weekends in the summer, MDA charity events, military appreciation days and rest area coffee fund raisers where the Chapter is always looking for volunteer help from the membership.

Q. What if I am not a very experienced rider?

A. Group riding can be a very different experience for new riders. Our website provides details on every ride. How long they are, type of difficulty etc. The Chapter also offers a group riding seminar every month and you can e-mail our safety officer at safety@lonewolfhog.com for more details.

Ladies of Harley (L.O.H.) - - - - FAQ's

Q. When does LOH meet?

A. LOH generally meets on the 4th Thursday of each month @6pm - generally at Lone Wolf Harley-Davidson, but check the website calendar at www.lonewolfhog.com for the most up-to-date information.

Q. Who may participate in LOH?

A. You must be a female with a either full or associate membership in H.O.G.® to be affiliated. To participate with Lone Wolf Chapter #2460 - Ladies of Harley you must also be current with Chapter dues.

Q. Are there separate dues for LOH?

A. LOH is included for female members of H.O.G. and Lone Wolf Chapter #2460!

Q. Do I need to ride my own motorcycle to participate with LOH?

A. Great news! You may participate whether you are a female passenger or female rider.

Q. May I bring a Guest to LOH?

A. Guests are welcome at meetings or LOH activities, please be sure your guest completes the proper release forms when applicable.
